# **Graduates**

In 2004-2005, the Open University conferred a B.A. degree on 1,859 students, of whom 88% reported that they had a Matriculation certificate. Master's degrees were awarded to 102 students. Six students completed certificate studies in Computer Science; 24 students were awarded teaching certificates in the Social Sciences, 17 in Psychology, and 4 in Computer Science.


