

Construction and Maintenance

The Dorothy de Rothschild Open University Campus in Raanana

Over the past year, construction and repairs on the Raanana campus continued. Necessary structural changes were made to move various departments and units from one location to another, the botanical garden was completed, and landscaping, including paths in various materials and external lighting, was concluded.

In terms of campus maintenance, numerous actions were taken to improve the electro-mechanical systems, and systems were installed to save energy and reduce expenses on electricity.

The Rennert Study Center in Ramat Aviv

Renovations were carried out on the previous campus in Ramat Aviv in order to convert it into a study center to serve students in Tel Aviv and central Israel. It will be the largest study center in the Tel Aviv area, and will enable the University to offer a wide range of morning courses. The study center has 31 classrooms (of which three classrooms can be combined to create one large hall), a library, cafeteria and offices.

The Beit Daniel Compound

The external renovation of the Carriage House (*Beit Hamerkavot*) at the rear of the Langa House was completed. We are in the process of detailed planning for restoring the building's interior, in cooperation with the Council for the Preservation of Buildings and Sites.
