Academic Teaching Staff

Preparations towards implementation of the collective agreement with the tutors: The Office of the Dean of Academic Studies, together with the Human Resources Administration, the Computer Center, the Teaching Services System, the Finance Department and the Planning, Organization and Methods Department, prepared intensively for a few months toward implementation of the new agreement with course tutors, to go into effect in the fall 2011 semester.

Employment of course coordinators: Alongside preparations for implementing the agreement with the tutors, the OUI also prepared for implementation of the amendments to the "Gershon" document, which defines course coordinators' conditions of employment.

Email for tutors: After several years of deliberation, a decision was made to establish a system of emails for course tutors under the OUI address. Their addresses will be distributed to students to enable them to communicate by email. Tutors may request that incoming mail be forwarded automatically to a private email address.


Memorial Site

The Open University Workforce

This year, a total of 1,238 people were employed at the Open University in 1,014.2 positions. Of these, 834 are women (683.6 positions) and 404 men (330.7 positions). The University also employed 1,024 tutors (500 women and 524 men).
