

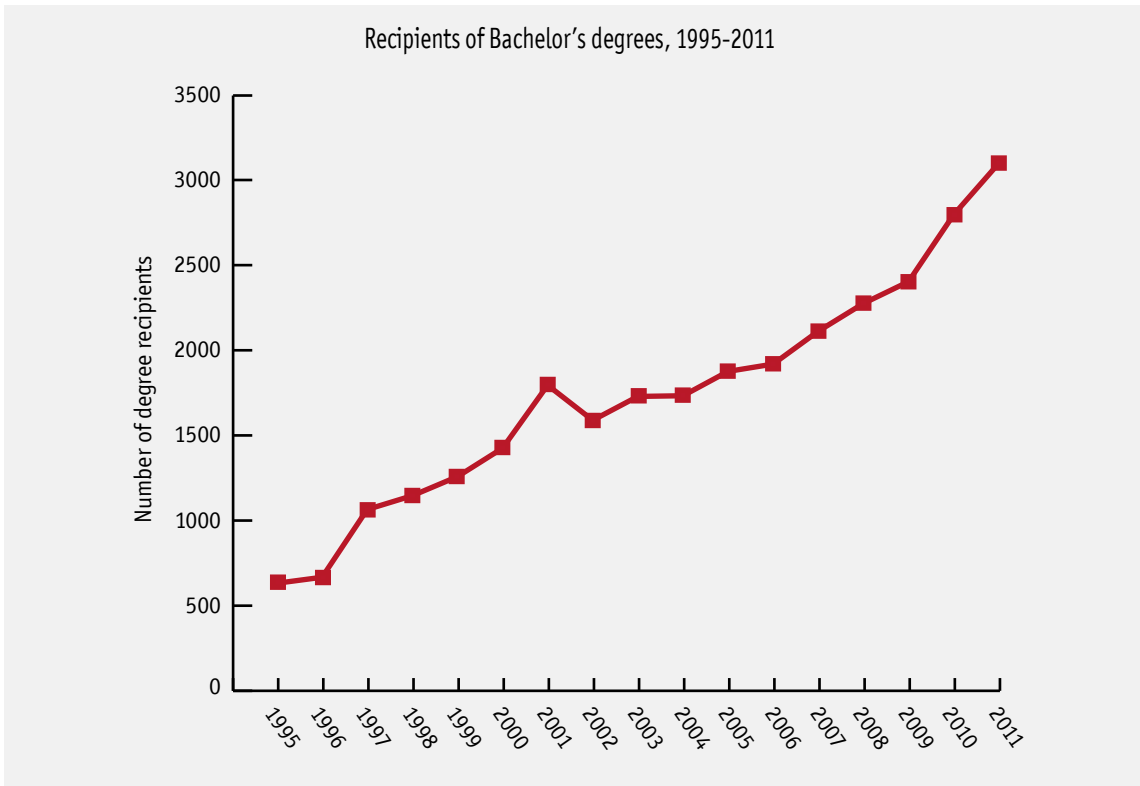
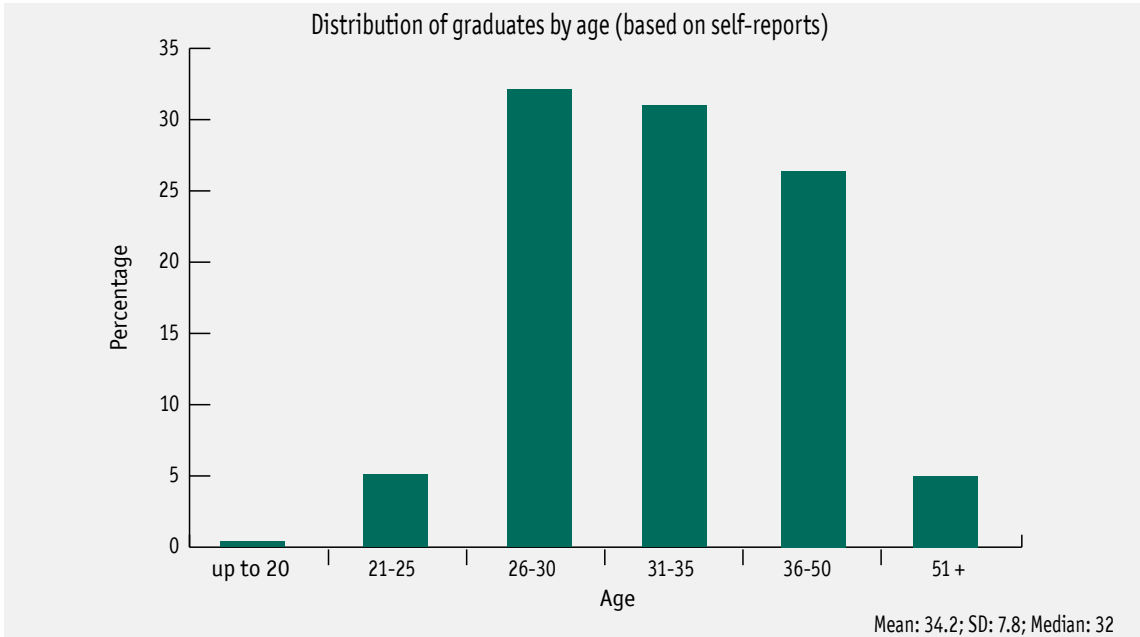

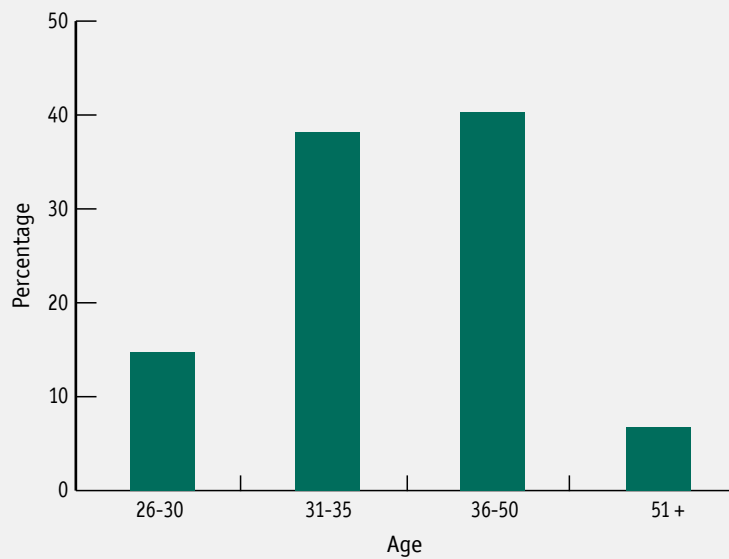

Distribution of Master's degrees, by discipline

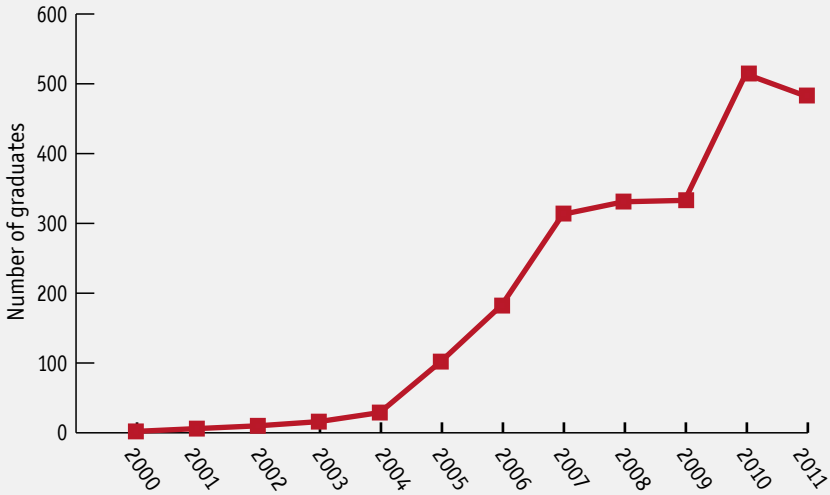
