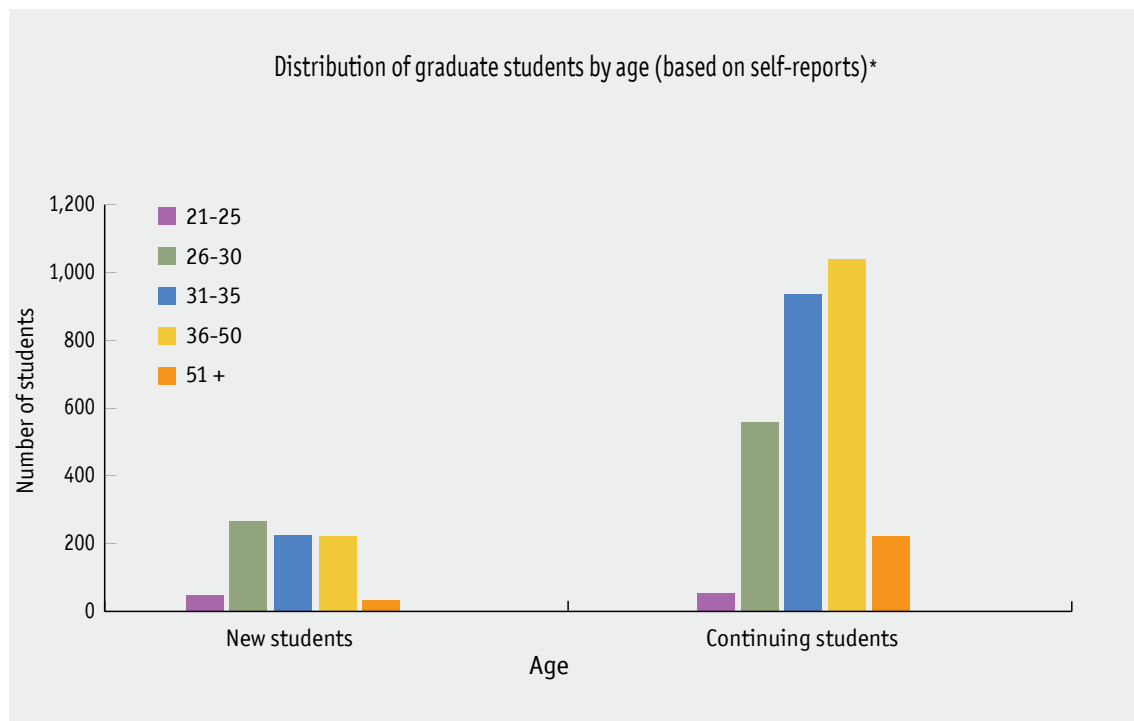
## Graduate Students and Enrollments (including qualifying courses)

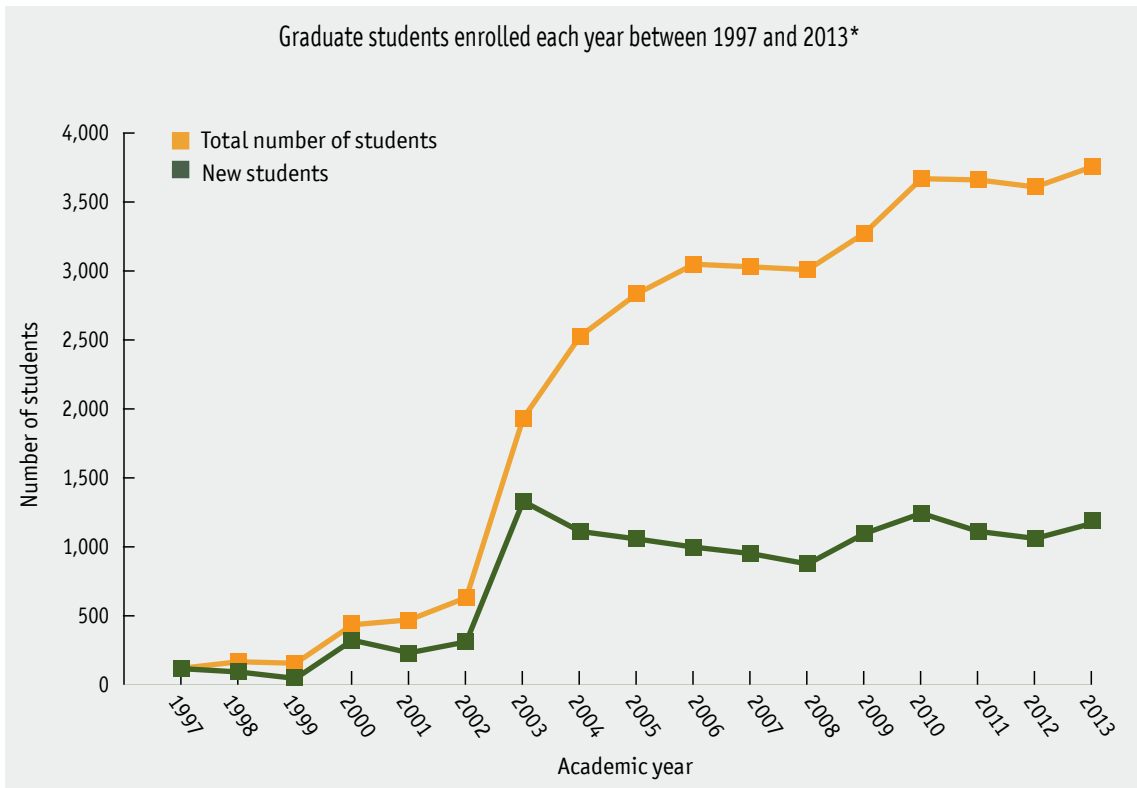
