Employee Council

The Employee Council is a body composed of representatives of Open University management and staff, both administrative and academic. The Council is still in the process of formulating its activity areas as the representative body of Open University employees.

Among the issues discussed this year at Council meetings: Employee evaluation, compensation and promotion; survey of private pension companies; problems related to transportation to the Raanana campus (changing the current transportation supplier, transportation to and from the Raanana intersection, developments concerning Raanana north intersection, dealing with auto theft on Ravutski street); catering at the Kfar Hayarok; air quality and radiation tests; the University budget.

Innovations and Improvements in the Intra-net System

Event calendar – Due to the numerous activities on the Raanana campus, there was a need for a computerized tool for showing all the activities and events at the OU for the convenience of faculty members and staff. The event calendar shows activities and events in the academic and administrative areas, regardless of whether they are intended for OU employees or for students and the general public (external events calendar). The calendar, which is on the Intra-net website, can be viewed using Outlook.

Employee search – The internal telephone directory was upgraded and currently offers various search options: searching for information about a specific employee (employee details, office and/or counseling hours, if relevant); telephone numbers of key academic and administrative units (department name, telephone number, fax, link to the department website if available and comments, if applicable); conference rooms and classrooms (location and telephone numbers).

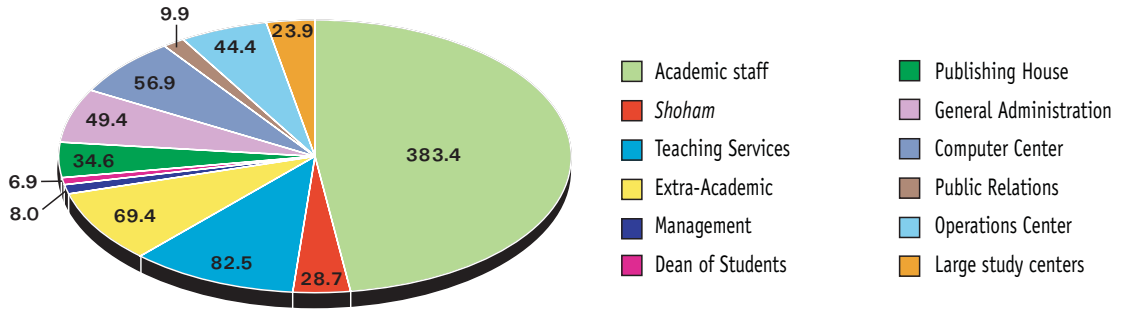

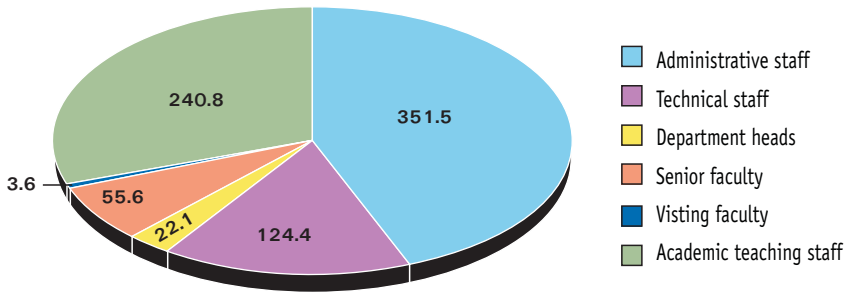
Daytime Cultural Events
